Overcome
Genesis 3:1-7, 6:5-8

What is 1 major thing that you want to see changed in your life in 2019?

Pray: As a group pray for each other's 1 thing.

Read: Genesis 3:1-7 & Genesis 6:5-8

1. Do you think that it is correct to attribute all that is wrong in the world to sin? Why or why not? (*Gospel project*)
2. How would you define sin? What do these verses say about the gravity and seriousness of it?
3. Look closely at the serpent's words in Genesis 3:1-7 what was he trying to implying about the nature and character of God through this temptation? (*Gospel project*)
4. What are some of the noticeable effects of sin in this passage? What can we learn of our own sin from it?
5. What is the Holy Spirit showing you in these verses?

In Christ, we receive his finished work, the payment, and forgiveness of our sins and sinfulness. This is by the act of placing our faith in the grace of God through Jesus. Often as followers of Jesus, we end up believing lies from the enemy and still living in the shadow or shame (identity) of sin. This is a tactic of the enemy to hinder our relationship with Jesus and in turn our effectiveness for the Gospel. In 1 John 1:9 there are two promises we receive when we confess our sins. **As a group declare these promises together and encourage one another as you bring it the cross.**

Jesus overcame evil with His righteousness, he is doing this in the life of every believer! Romans 12:21 NIV - "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."
