Currently we are to carry on as normal with all services and gatherings. Everyone should use normal health precautions that hopefully we all follow already: regular hand washing, cover coughs and sneezes, stay home if sick, and see a doctor if you have flu/ cold-like symptoms.

We already disinfect every area of the church weekly, and will increase these measures moving forward. We provide hand sanitizer throughout the building and in classrooms as well.

In the case of an outbreak at CCC of the CoronaVirus, we will follow the proper quarantine and cleaning measures outlined by health officials. Programs and services will be suspended as needed.

In the case of a state of emergency, we will adhere to the guidelines laid out by government officials.
