

Church on Fire | Wait | Acts 1:1-5

Open in Prayer: Share a words of praise and reverence to God the Father, acknowledge Jesus as Lord and authority, and invite the Holy Spirit to lead and speak in your group.

Discuss: What is the hardest part about waiting?

Study: Read Acts 1:1-5 together

1. The name Theophilus means “God-lover”, knowing this who would you say the book of Acts was written to?
2. Who was Jesus speaking through? What does that teach us about when we are sharing the Word with others?
3. Read Acts 1:3 and 1 Corinthians 15:6 why is this important?
4. According to John 14:15-18 what is the gift that Jesus had promised in verse 4?
5. Who is mentioned in verses 4-5 and what is proof of?
6. What does it mean to be baptized by the Holy Spirit?
7. What is more appropriate to ask a person “have you been” or “are you baptized in Holy Spirit”? What is the difference? What about you?
8. When does a person receive the Holy Spirit? (Eph 1:13-14) If we have Him what does it look like to wait on the Holy Spirit?

Live it out:

What area of your life this week do you need to invite the Holy Spirit to lead you and then to wait Him?
