A Man After God's Own Heart

Discuss: When you do wrong does it feel wrong to go to God in prayer?

Read Together:

Acts 13:22-23 NIV - "After removing Saul, he made David their king. God testified concerning him: 'I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.' 23 "From this man's descendants God has brought to Israel the Savior Jesus, as he promised."

1. Thinking back to this past week's sermon, what was the reason David was referred to as a man after God's own heart?

2. Read Psalm 51 What can we learn from how David poured his heart to God after he had done a terrible thing?

3. How did David describe the character and actions of God?

4. Have you experienced this statement to be true in your own life?
"When we are in pursuit of God's heart, our life will be focused on the greatness of God, not on our own greatness" Explain

5. Read John 6:38-40 How does David model Jesus for us? Based on these examples from David and Jesus how can we live out being a person in pursuit of God's heart?
