Group Check-in: What's something you can celebrate this week? What's a challenge for you right now?

Read: Luke 4:16-21

1. What stands out to you in Luke 4:16–21? What does it show us about His identity and authority?

2. What does “anointed” mean, and why is it significant that Jesus fulfills the roles of Prophet, Priest, and King? Which of those roles (Prophet, Priest, King) feels most personally meaningful to you right now?

3. Jesus lists His anointed mission in Luke 4:18–19. Which part of His mission do you feel most drawn to share or most in need of today? - Good news for the poor - Freedom for the captives - Sight for the blind - Freedom for the oppressed - The year of the Lord's favor. How have you experienced Jesus doing this in your own life?

4. What does it mean to invoke Jesus (call on His name, authority, power), and what does His presence tend to evoke in you? How have you seen His presence evoke hope, repentance, faith, freedom, conviction, or worship?

5. Since the Anointed One anoints His people, what does it look like for you to live an anointed life—of: (discuss each one)
