| | Name: Jesus Origin: Hebrew (Yeshua) → Greek (Iēsous) → English (Jesus) Word Breakdown: Yeshua = Ye (shortened form of Yahweh) + shua (from yasha, meaning 'to save' or 'to deliver') Meaning: 'Yahweh saves' or 'The Lord is salvation' Significance: - 'Ye' refers to God's personal name, Yahweh - 'Shua' emphasizes the act of saving or delivering - Together, the name Jesus declares His divine purpose as the Savior sent by God to redeem humanity |
