 - b. About us
 - c. What does it tell us about who God is?
2. What does it mean for you?
 - a. Is there a command to follow?
 - b. Is there a warning to heed?
 - c. Is there a promise to claim?
3. How does this promise encourage you?
 - a. How does it challenge you to grow in your faith?
 - b. Does it overcome a lie you've believed or affirm a truth you needed to hear?
4. What will you do in response to what you've learned?
 - a. What is the pathway to God's promise?
 - b. Will anything need to change in order to receive the promise?
 - c. How can your group help?

Memory Verse: (practice together)
